Ulnooweg Education Centre (UEC) is seeking a skilled Education Program Manager to launch a new mobile program serving First Nations Communities across New Brunswick while managing a team of program facilitators within the technology and education space.

THE OPPORTUNITY:

Reporting to Director, UEC the Education Program Manager will be responsible for managing the delivery of science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM) and cultural educational programs. Educational programming will be delivered via a vehicular mobile unit, equipped with technology-enabled curriculum and project information to provide grassroots, community-based educational sessions from our course catalogue. The Education Program Manager will initiate the co-creation of this course catalogue alongside Ulnooweg's Cultural Officer. As the program evolves, the responsibilities of the Education Program Manager will change with it. Adaptability is a key attribute of a successful candidate. This role is based in Fredericton, New Brunswick.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensure that all projects and programs created by the incumbent's team include the knowledge systems grounded in Etuaptmumk – the gift of multiple perspectives – also referred to as a Two-Eyed Seeing approach.
- Work with the Cultural Officer to co-create the course catalogue for STEAM programs offered through the mobile unit, with a focus on enhancing educational outcomes for students K-12 through innovative teaching methodologies.
- Coordinate educational delivery events with Indigenous communities across New Brunswick.
- Capture, summarize and report on delivery metrics to Program
 Funders and Grantors, liaising with this group through a combination of regular in-person and online meetings.
- Oversee maintenance of the mobile unit to ensure the vehicle is in good working condition and schedule maintenance as needed.
- Lead a team of two to four program facilitators.
- Manage and train the program facilitators on the course catalogue
